Modern technology constantly updates the way we live. At home, different appliances operate everyday and make life easier. On the other hand, having a lot of these devices also entails consuming more electrical energy. Briefly discuss how you and your family observe proper energy consumption using these home appliances.

Answer A:

The most utilized home appliances we have are the refrigerator, TV, air conditioner, gas range, and the heater. To ensure proper energy consumption, we turn off or unplug an appliance when not in use. We regulate TV viewing among family members. The air conditioner is turned on mostly during summer season and the heater is used during cold winter days. Our gas range uses liquefied petroleum gas instead of electricity. We clean the house using a broom and cloth instead of the vacuum cleaner. Other electrical devices like the computer have regulated use as well. We are glad that our electric bill remains low. Our family lives a simple lifestyle, so we minimize dependence on technology. We also spend much of our time outdoors.

Answer B:

Answer A:

Online banking and traditional banking work similarly, but online banking has become more appealing for various reasons. First, online banking is more accessible than traditional banking because it is not bound to inconvenient locations and fixed schedules. Traditional banking also requires every transaction to be made face—to—face, while with online banking, physical presence is not necessary for performing transactions. Online banking can be done anytime and anywhere as long as you have access to a computer and the Internet. In addition, online banking offers higher interest rates as compared with traditional banking. Finally, banking activities like money transfer and bill payments are faster with online banking as they can be accomplished within a minute. For these advantages, the number of online banking users follows an upward trend.

Your cousin, who would be studying in another city, wants to open a bank account online. She drops by your house and requests you to assist her with the application. Try to help her out.

Answer A:

Hi Sarah, let me try to assist you with your application. The first thing you have to do is choose the bank that suits your purpose. Your parents may advise you on this. After that, check the bank website. On the site, click the service or product that's right for you. Since you're a student, it would be appropriate to open a student account. Look for the instruction that says "Open Bank Account". Once you click this, the succeeding instructions would just guide you. Several questions would be asked and you would be asked to fill out a membership or registration form. Be sure to be ready with the requisites the bank would be asking you. Some banks would require you going to a local branch to submit some papers such as proof of student status, residential certificate or any billing statement. Some banks consider the information you submitted online as legally binding, but there are some that oblige submission of important documents. The account would not be activated unless you send them. It would take a few days for them to notify you about your new account.
